ARMORBEARER TRAINING KIT

How to Organize Your Armorbearer's Team

Remember, this is a model only so that you may personalize or tailor it to your specific armor bearer's team and duties. I have included a sample:

- mission statement
- general requirements
- general duties
- ministry dress code
- qualifications of an Armorbearer
- one year commitment statement

Include your church's (house vision) so that you may see it and run together. Whether you put it at the end or in front of your material, make sure all Armorbearers have read your church's overall vision. You will be structuring your team around what God has called your pastor and Church Body to do, right.

MISSION STATEMENT

To serve and support our leader(s) as (we) fulfill the vision of _____ Church.

General Requirements:

- Understand God's delegated authority
- Commit to the vision of Church
- Work faithfully in the mission of _____ armorbearer's team
- Serve motivated by the heart of a servant (no hidden agendas)
- General Duties:
 - Assist pastors and leaders as assigned
 - Shield pastors and leaders as needed
 - Protect Shepherd's Lounge (green room)
 - Create (prayerfully) a restful, refreshing atmosphere in Shepherd's Lounge or Green Room
 - Provide refreshments (drinks, food, etc.) at/or between

- services-any time necessary
- Serve ministry guests
- Provide escort for ministry guest and family into church service
- Provide personal pickup for ministry guest (airport, hotel)
- Serve at special ministry functions (women and men)
- Enlist prayer warriors

MINISTRY DRESS CODE:

Proper dress lets others know that you take your position, seriously. Also, our leaders will more readily recognize and treat you as a fellow minister if you look like one. Be neat, clean, and well-groomed. Dress modestly. (Some teams wear uniforms) Avoid clothing short or tight. Please conform to the following standard of dress while serving.

Women

- Nice dress
- Modestly fit

Men

- Sunday best clothing
- Nice slacks and clean shirt
- Properly shaven
- Polished shoes

Both

- Clean and neat hair
- Clean hands and body
- Breath mints

QUALIFICATIONS OF AN ARMORBEARER IN LOCAL CHURCH

1. Be a member of Church for at least one year.
2. Attend the Armorbearer's class (Send for books, host your class or sign-up for eWorkshop Training at <http://www.armorbearercoachseries.com>)
3. Complete the volunteer request form.
4. Be an (already) active and consistent participator in volunteer ministry.
5. Supply two references (ie., ministry leader, elder, or pastor)
6. Write a short explanation letter answering the question: Why do you want to be an Armorbearer for _____ church?
7. Commit to volunteer a minimum of one year in this position.
